Highlights


Paddy/Rice

- Harvesting of paddy was underway in all major producing districts during the month. Consequently, the producer prices of most paddy varieties have decreased.
- The supply of Keeri Samba increased following the Yala harvest, leading to an 8% price drop.
- The average retail prices of Samba Grade 1, Keeri Samba, Nadu Grade 1, and raw white exceeded the government-regulated maximum retail price (MRP).


Vegetables

- Prices of all the vegetables have decreased due to increased supply from the main producing areas.
- Retail prices of up-country vegetables have decreased by 9%-41% and prices of low-country vegetables have decreased by 10%-60%.

1. Paddy/Rice

Crop Situation

According to the Crop Forecast from the Department of Agriculture (Yala 2024, Vol. 4), the paddy cultivation target for the 2024 Yala season is 545,113 hectares. By the end of August 2024, the reported sown extent was 488,957 hectares, achieving 90% of the target. Based on the sown extent reported as of the end of August 2024, the forecasted paddy production, accounting for crop losses, is estimated at 2.01 million metric tons.

Producer Prices

Harvesting of paddy was underway in all major producing districts during the month. Consequently, the producer prices of most paddy varieties have decreased. The producer price of short-grain paddy ranged from Rs. 98.00 to Rs. 125.00/kg, with a decline of 1–6% observed in Anuradhapura, Dehiattakandiya, and Kalawewa while the largest decrease was recorded in Nikaweratiya.

The producer price of Keeri Samba ranged from Rs. 102.00 to Rs. 125.00/kg, showing decreases of 11% and 6% in Anuradhapura and Dehiattakandiya, respectively. However, the producer price of long-grain white paddy increased across all producing areas, with the highest increase recorded in Nikaweratiya.

Compared to the same period last year, producer prices for all paddy varieties have risen across all price collection areas, with long-grain white experiencing the most significant price increase, ranging from 20–35%. However, the producer price of Keeri Samba dropped by 21% and 16% in Polonnaruwa and Dehiattakandiya, respectively.

Rice - Prices Demand/Supply Situation

Wholesale Prices

Wholesale prices for all rice varieties, except Nadu, decreased by 1–6% compared to the previous month. The largest price drop, 6%, was recorded for Keeri Samba due to increased supply, with prices ranging from Rs. 240.00 to Rs. 315.00/kg. Wholesale prices for Samba Grade I ranged from Rs. 230.00 to Rs. 240.00/kg, reflecting a 2% decrease compared to the previous month.

The average wholesale prices of Samba Grade I and Keeri Samba exceeded the maximum retail price, even at the wholesale level. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for all rice varieties increased by 5–28%, with raw red showing the highest rise of Rs. 43.00/kg.

Retail Prices

Retail prices for all rice varieties, except Keeri Samba, showed little change compared to the previous month. The supply of Keeri Samba increased following the Yala harvest, leading to an 8% price drop. The average retail prices of Samba Grade 1, Keeri Samba, Nadu Grade 1, and raw white exceeded the government-regulated maximum retail price (MRP).

Imported Ponne Samba was also available in retail markets, with prices ranging from Rs. 280.00 to Rs. 320.00/kg. Compared to the same month last year, retail prices for all rice varieties rose by 2–24%, with Keeri Samba experiencing the highest increase of Rs. 53.00/kg.

2. Other Field Crops

2.1 Chilli

Crop Situation

The targeted extent for green chilli cultivation during the Yala season of 2024 was 7,374 ha. By the end of August 2024, 5,509 ha had been cultivated, achieving 75% of the target. Crops are currently at various growth stages across the main producing areas. In the Anuradhapura district, 586 ha had been cultivated by the end of August, representing 95% of the district's targeted extent. Based on the cultivated extent by the end of August, the expected production of green chilli for the Yala season is estimated at 35,196 Mt. Key production contributions are projected from Puttalam (11%), Anuradhapura (13%), Mahaweli areas (10%), Jaffna (8%), Matale (7%), and Batticaloa (7%).

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The supply of green chilli from major producing areas increased this month, leading to significant price reductions. Wholesale prices of green chilli dropped by approximately Rs.133.00/kg, while retail prices decreased by about Rs.89.00/kg. Wholesale prices ranged from Rs.100.00–450.00/kg, and retail prices were between Rs.220.00–800.00/kg. The highest producer prices for green chilli

were reported from Embilipitiya, with prices ranging from Rs.210.00–532.00/kg during August. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices of green chilli have declined by 40% and 12%, respectively.

In August 2024, 3,637 Mt of dried chillies were imported, a reduction of 431 Mt compared to the previous month. The average CIF price was Rs.542.83/kg, reflecting a decrease of Rs.54.87/kg from the prior month. Despite this, the wholesale price of imported dried chillies decreased by about Rs.13.00/kg, while the retail price increased by Rs.4.00/kg. Wholesale prices ranged from Rs.650.00–800.00/kg, and retail prices varied between Rs.800.00–1,200.00/kg. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices of imported dried chillies decreased by approximately 28% and 22%, respectively.

2.2 Big Onion and Red Onion

Crop Situation

The targeted extent for big onion cultivation during the 2024 Yala season was approximately 3,943 ha. By the end of August 2024, only 1,428 ha had been cultivated, representing 36% of the target. In the Matale district, the targeted extent was 1,647 ha, with 421 ha cultivated by the end of August, achieving 26% of the target.

Compared to the previous Yala season, both the cultivated extent and production have increased significantly by 225% and 191%, respectively. In the Matale district, the cultivated extent of big onion has increased by 316 ha compared to the last Yala season.

The targeted extent for red onion cultivation during the 2024 Yala season was 3,489 ha. By the end of August 2024, 2,664 ha had been cultivated, achieving 76% of the target. The Jaffna district recorded the highest targeted extent (2,086 ha) and the highest cultivated extent (1,880 ha), representing 90% of its target. The estimated production for this Yala season is 29,919 Mt, with 84% of the supply originating from the Jaffna (70%) and Puttalam (14%) districts.

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The market supply of big onions in August 2024 continued to rely entirely on imports. A total of 20,499 Mt of big onions were imported, 474 Mt less than the previous month. The average CIF price stood at Rs.144.36/kg, showing minimal change from the prior month. However, the wholesale price of imported big onions increased by Rs.17.00/kg, while the retail price decreased by Rs.4.00/kg. Wholesale prices ranged between Rs.130.00–260.00/kg, and retail prices ranged from Rs.180.00–320.00/kg. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices of imported big onions increased by approximately 41% and 44%, respectively.

The supply of Sinnan and Vedalan red onions from main producing areas increased this month, leading to price reductions. Wholesale and retail prices of Vedalan red onion decreased by Rs.64.00/kg and Rs.78.00/kg, respectively. Wholesale prices ranged between Rs.230.00–420.00/kg, while retail prices ranged from Rs.340.00–560.00/kg. Sinnan red onion stocks were available at wholesale prices of Rs.160.00–220.00/kg and retail prices of Rs.320.00–420.00/kg. For imported red onions, both wholesale and retail prices dropped by Rs.44.00/kg and Rs.27.00/kg, respectively. Compared to the same period last year, the retail price of Vedalan red onion increased by about 7%.

3. Vegetables

Crop Situation

The cultivation progress for vegetables during the 2024 Yala season has reached 82% (14,302 ha) for up-country vegetables and 96% (21,904 ha) for low-country vegetables. Notably, Ash Plantain (184%), Kekiri (186%), Brinjal (106%), and Winged Bean (108%) have exceeded their respective

cultivation targets. This Yala season targets a total cultivation extent of 40,364 ha, comprising 17,517 ha for up-country vegetables and 22,847 ha for low-country vegetables. The total expected vegetable production for the season is estimated at 456,070 MT, according to *Crop Forecast, Vol. 04, Yala-2024* (Socio-Economics & Planning Center, Department of Agriculture).

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Vegetable prices have decreased significantly this month due to increased supply from major producing areas.

Wholesale Prices

Up-country Vegetables: Prices fell by 5%–58%, with the steepest drop recorded for beans (Rs.221.00/kg). Tomato prices declined by 43% (Rs.127.00/kg).

Low-country Vegetables: Wholesale prices dropped by 5%–59%, except for brinjal and ash plantain, which rose by 4% and 2%, respectively. Bitter gourd experienced the highest price reduction (Rs.171.00/kg). Green chilli and lime prices also fell by 34% and 37%, respectively.

Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices of most vegetable varieties increased by 1%–151%, with the highest increase for capsicum. However, carrot, ladies' fingers, cucumber, bitter gourd, and drumstick prices decreased by 2%–53%.

Retail Prices

Up-country Vegetables: Prices decreased by 9%–41%, with beetroot showing the largest reduction (41%, Rs.218.00/kg). Tomato prices dropped by 35%.

Low-country Vegetables: Retail prices fell by 10%–60%, except for brinjal, which increased by 1%. Capsicum recorded the highest average price (Rs.820.00/kg), while cucumber had the lowest (Rs.172.00/kg). Green chilli and lime prices declined by 14% and 38%, respectively.

Compared to last year, retail prices of most vegetables increased by 3%–90%, led by capsicum. However, carrot, bitter gourd, and drumstick prices dropped by 5%–21%.

4. Fruits

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

In August, the prices of most major fruit types increased due to a reduced supply from key producing areas. Prices of anamlu, ambun, and seeni banana varieties rose by 3%–6% due to lower supply. However, the price of kolikuttu bananas decreased by 15%. Prices for large and medium-sized pineapples increased slightly, by about 3%. All mango varieties experienced price increases,

with karthakolomban showing the highest rise at 120%, followed by vilad mango at 41%, primarily due to the tail end of the harvesting season.

Considering the other types of fruit varieties, the prices of all the types except slime apple have decreased with the highest price decrease recorded for wood apple (70%), followed by orange (10%), papaw (9%) and avocado (8%) due to availability of sufficient stocks.

Compared to the same period of last year, the current wholesale prices of most of the fruit varieties have increased with the highest price increase of 100% reported for slime apple (Table 4.1).

According to the price behaviour of the wholesale market, the retail prices of most of the major fruit types have increased while the prices of other fruit types have decreased in August. Considering the price behaviour for banana varieties, the highest price increase of 8% was reported for *ambun* banana, followed by *anamalu* (6%). During the month, the prices ranged between Rs.400.00-650.00/kg for *kolikuttu*, Rs.180.00-300.00/kg for *ambul* banana and Rs.170.00-280.00/kg for *seeni* banana in Colombo and suburb markets. Considering the price behaviour for pineapple varieties, the prices of all the sizes have increased further in the range of 6%-9% due to increased wholesale prices and the prices ranged between Rs.500.00-700.00/fruit for medium size fruit in Colombo suburbs markets. Among the mango varieties, the prices of *karthakolomban* and *vilad* have increased by 124% and 62% respectively due to low stock position.

Considering the other types of fruits, the retail prices of wood apple (53%), orange (11%) and passion fruit (8%) have decreased in line with the decreased wholesale prices for those type of fruits. However, the price of slime apple (33%) has increased. Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail prices of most of the fruit varieties have increased with the highest price increase of 61% reported for orange and avocado (Table 4.2).

Exports/Imports of Fruits

According to Sri Lanka Customs, Sri Lanka had exported 1,313 mt of fresh fruits in August, 2023 to the value of Rs.180 mn. Of the total exported quantity of fresh fruits, 93% were papaw, followed by pineapple (4%). Compared to August 2023 (1,587 mt), the exported quantity had decreased during this year (Table 4.3).

With reference to imports, Sri Lanka had imported 833 mt of fresh fruits during the month and the value was Rs.388 mn. Apple was the mostly imported fruit type with the quantity of 343 mt, followed by grapes (314 mt). Compared to the same period of last year, the imported quantity had increased during this year (Table 4.4).

Headline inflation, as measured by the year-on-year (Y-o-Y) change in the Colombo Consumer Price Index (CCPI, 2021=100) decelerated sharply to 0.5% in August 2024 from 2.4% in July 2024. Food inflation (Y-o-Y) decelerated to 0.8% in August 2024 from 1.5% in July 2024.

In line with the deceleration of food prices, prices of most of the fish varieties observed a price drop in August. High supplies received to the market during the middle phase of the main season in Southern and Western coasts.

The highest price drop was reported for thora at 16% followed by paraw and kelawalla at 18%. Prices of remaining varieties had decreased by less than 8%, except for balaya. However, prices of balaya had increased by 10%, following a high price drop in July. In comparison to the same period in the previous year, wholesale prices for most fresh fish varieties had dropped, ranging from 5% to 34%, with the highest drop reported for salaya.

In line with price variation in the wholesale market, prices of most of the fish varieties, had dropped in the retail market. The highest price drop was reported for mora at 8%. Prices of hurulla and paraw had decreased by 7%.

Prices of remaining varieties had dropped in the range of 2% - 6%, except for balaya. Meanwhile, prices of balaya had increased by 4% in the retail market. When compared to the same period of the previous year, retail prices for most of the fresh fish varieties had decreased, with the most significant decrease noted for salaya at 29%.

Dried Fish- Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

In line with the price variation in fresh fish prices, wholesale prices of most of the dried fish varieties experienced a decrease in August 2024, mainly due to high supply of raw materials (fresh fish). The highest price drop at the wholesale level was recorded for sprats as 17%. Additionally, prices of mora and balaya had decreased at 5% and 4%. The prices of remaining dried fish varieties had dropped by less than 3%, except for anguluwa (imported) and salaya. Compared to the same period of the previous year, wholesale prices for most of the dried fish varieties had dropped with the highest was reported for sprats at 35%.

In line with the wholesale price variation, prices of most of the dried fish varieties had dropped at the retail market. The highest price drop at the retail level was recorded for salaya at 5%. Prices of all the remaining fish varieties had dropped by less than 3%, except for maduwa. However, prices of maduwa had increased by 7% at the retail level. Compared to the same period of the previous year, retail prices of most of the dried fish varieties had dropped with the highest was reported for balaya at 19%.

Because of the combined effect of high supply and low demand (due to high supply of alternative protein sources - fresh fish), prices of eggs dropped considerably in August, compared to last month. At the wholesale level, prices of brown eggs had dropped by 16% per egg and prices of white eggs has dropped by 17% per egg. When it comes to the retail level, price of an egg had decreased by 16% for both brown egg and white egg. Average retail price was Rs. 45.00 per brown egg and Rs. 43.00 per white egg. Compared to the same period of the previous year, prices of brown and white eggs have decreased by 6% and 7% respectively at the retail level.
